Bird mode intelligently optimizes radar gain and sea clutter controls for targeting seabirds, giving anglers the intelligence they need to locate baitfish and their trophy predators.

The Cyclone family delivers six high-power solid-state options for long-range and all-weather performance. Retail prices range from £6,495 to £8,995.
